Membership Club Charter (Official English Version)

I. History and Background

The HUASHANG FOUNDATION Membership Club was formally established ten years ago. However, the founding team has provided comprehensive U.S.-based business services to Chinese enterprises and distinguished entrepreneurs for more than twenty years.

In its early stages, entrepreneur delegation visits to the United States began in Houston and expanded to major American cities for business exchanges and project cooperation. As technology companies, manufacturing enterprises, and publicly listed corporations established branches in the U.S., the Foundation broadened its services to include:

- Business matchmaking
- Investment advisory
- Corporate establishment support
- Education and family planning services

Driven by the increasing demand for cross-border cooperation, the HUASHANG FOUNDATION Membership Club was officially formed and has since developed into:

- An international resource integration platform
- A strategic think tank for entrepreneurs
- A bridge for U.S.–China economic cooperation

The Club is committed to building a global entrepreneurial community and facilitating international business collaboration and capital connectivity.

The HUASHANG FOUNDATION Membership Club is established under the auspices of HUASHANG FOUNDATION. It consists of entrepreneurs dedicated to international cooperation and cross-border development, joining on a voluntary basis.

The Club operates under the guidance and supervision of the HUASHANG FOUNDATION Board

and serves enterprises and individuals seeking global resource alignment and strategic development.

- To create a premier global resource integration platform

Chapter II – Organizational Structure

Article 1 – Organizational Bodies

The Club consists of:

1. Executive Council
2. Secretariat

Executive Council Responsibilities:

Formulates development strategies and makes major decisions.

Secretariat Responsibilities:

Manages daily operations and membership services.

The Secretariat includes:

- Event Planning Department
- Network & Information Department
- Consulting & Capital Services Department

Article 2 – Composition

- Chairman: Served by the Chairman of HUASHANG FOUNDATION
- Vice Chairpersons: Nominated by the Chairman
- Executive Secretary-General: Responsible for daily operations

The Chairman, Vice Chairpersons, and Executive Secretary-General collectively form the Executive Council.
